On May 24, 2021, updated aasj.org website with Executive Order 242 link, with notes highlighting New Jersey specific rules for indoor meetings. Phase I effective May 28, 2021, eased mask mandate and 6-foot social distancing. Phase II effective June 4, 2021, lifted indoor gathering capacity restrictions. Note: In New Jersey, an AA Group or Meeting, or a landlord, may still impose their own mask requirement, however, No AA Group, Meeting, or landlord may require all to not wear masks.
